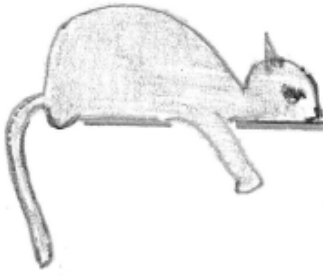


Nobody's Perfect
